

Minutes of the Allamakee County Conservation Board

The Allamakee County Conservation Board met in regular session at 1:00 P.M. July 2, 2019 in the Board Office located at 1944 Columbus Rd. Lansing, Iowa. Board members present were as follows: Jeanie Carroll, Marilyn Clark, Jesse Delaney, Dennis Koenig, and Bill Moody. Also attending were Conservation Board staff members Erin Cuban, Ross Geerdes, James Janett, and Jarrod Olson.

The meeting was called to order at 1:00 P.M. and the minutes from the previous meeting were read and approved upon a motion by Delaney second Clark, all in favor, motion carried.

There were no comments during public comment time.

The Board reviewed claims, revenues, and the ending balance for the 2018-2019 Fiscal Year Budget. The ending balance of the 2018-2019 Fiscal Year Budget was \$2,249.00 which returned to the General Basic Account.

Updates were provided to the Board regarding the FEMA clean up status and the reimbursement process for the repairs. Expenditures for FEMA claims are assigned an object number from the construction budget line item. The Board will have to complete a budget amendment for the 2019-2020 Fiscal Year Budget for the FEMA expenditures and reimbursements.

Program and event summaries were presented to the Board.

Other items included repairing the new concrete on Columbus road that was damaged during the recent rock slide, request for landing improvements at Volney Park on Yellow River, partnering with Archeologist Dave Stanley to complete mound surveys in Allamakee County, and public usage at the Hartley Bridge on the Upper Iowa River that is no longer in service.

There being no additional business a motion was made to adjourn the meeting by Delaney, second Koenig, all in favor, motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 2:15 P.M.
